WASHCARE GUIDELINE


100%Cotton is a fully breathable, natural fibre. Polyester is a synthetic fibre.

The heavier the weight of the cotton fabric, the less durable it becomes.

Durable fabric is essential for culinary garments as they are worn extensively and washed regularly.

As a natural fibre, 100% Cotton tends to be more expensive than it's synthetic counterparts.

The composition of CulinaryWorks Basic Culinary Range is 65% Polyester 35% Cotton, which is the perfect blend allowing durability within the garment as well as affordablity to all chefs in the hospitality industry.



LUKE WARM WASH

Wash your garment in luke warm water, this is the perfect temperature to clean your culinary garment and prevent staining whilst not compromising the quality or shape of your garment.

DO NOT BLEACH

Bleach breaks down the cotton fibers in the cloth and may result in your garment being damaged over time. The branding on our garments should not be bleached.

LOW IRON

The ideal way to keep your garment in great condition is to wash and hang to dry, minor creases can be removed with a low temperature iron.

DO NOT TUMBLE DRY

Leave this garment to drip dry on a drying rack or on your wash line instead of putting it in the tumble dryer. This will maintain the longevity of your garment.
